Some say that Hermaphroditus is a god, born with a body which is a combination of a man and of a woman. A body which is beautiful and delicate like that of a woman, but has the masculine quality and vigour of a man. This wine is neither red nor white nor orange or rosé, but its own unique creation. It contains a combination of different red and white grapes fermented on skins. It is beautiful, delicate and aromatic like a white, has structure and body of a light red, and is refreshing like a rosé.

Simply, a combination of red and white grapes fermented together naturally on skins. Grapes include: pinot noir, viognier, chardonnay, sauv blanc, along with other varieties. Its a field blend of a little bit of each of our vineyards and grapes we brought into the winery for the 2019 harvest.

Taste: Light to medium bodied. with an orange pink hue. Aromas of strawberries, pineapple and apricot. A little wierd, different, and delicious.
